- Wall Hangings and small quilts measuring no smaller than <u>12"</u> no larger than 50" per side
- Seeking a variety of quilting techniques to demonstrate the depth of talent of the guild's membership.
- No cost to enter.
- Members can submit 2 entries.
 Initially, first choice entries will be accepted. If additional spaces become available, 2nd entry will be considered, depending upon size.
- Hanging sleeves are required for all entries. Instructions posted on website.
- Quilts to be "SOLD" ~
 Library staff will handle transaction,
 20% commission fee. The quilt will
 remain in exhibit till July 31, then
 released to customer and payment
 processed to member.

Quilt take down will begin at 3:30 p.m. and all entries must be picked up by 9:00 p.m.





<u>Volunteers</u> needed to assist with instructions and to supervise project. Ratio of 2 students per volunteer. Students will complete 2 finished blocks.




July 19th WORKSHOP:
