A New Spin on the Drunkard's Path SUPPLY LIST

This workshop will explore all the variations that are featured in the book: *A New Spin on Drunkard's Path*, C&T Publishing 2016. We will begin the day by exploring curved piecing, then will work through making the 6 variations that are in the book. At the end of the day you will have examples of all the block variations that you can use for reference or possibly turn into a quilt project (table runner/table topper/quilt). The day will focus on curved piecing technique and exploring the design possibilities of the variations.

Supplies:

6 inch (finished) Drunkard Path Acrylic Template

Any type that you have will be fine. My preferred templates are from Marti Michell. I will have some for sale the day of the class, and some to borrow. If you have other sizes of Drunkard's Path templates feel free to bring them along - you will need to adjust the cutting instructions to fit your particular template.

Fabric scissors

Marking pencil/tool that will show up on your fabric

Rotary cutter with sharp blade

Rotary cutting ruler (at least 23 inches long)

Rotary cutting mat (OK to share one with others if you like)

Pins

Neutral Piecing Thread

Sewing Machine with quarter-inch foot.

Iron/Ironing board or pad

Recommended Book: *A New Spin on Drunkard's Path*, C&T Publishing 2016. (I will have some books for sale the day of the class)

Fabric: Bring a variety of fabrics.

Solids and tonals work great.

Larger Prints will also work, just be sure you have other fabrics that contrast.

Bring at least 3-5 different lights, 3-5 different mediums and 3-5 different darks.

Make sure you have a good amount of contrast

(1/2 yard cuts - If you want to work scrappy you can bring 1/4 yard cuts or fat quarters -just double the amount)
